**PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD:** We move from palm waving and crying “Hosanna!” to Christ our risen Lord to the saving story of his passion and death on the cross, from a journey of joy to a winding walk of suffering, leading from the upper room of the Last Supper to the garden of Gethsamane to the house of Caiaphas, then to Pilate’s house and courtyard, and finally, the climb to the hill of Calvary. We remember that Jesus was spat on, struck, stripped, scourged, and crowned with thorns. He was denounced, mocked, and ridiculed. What was it like for him to go from hearing “Hosanna!” to “Crucify him!” within a few days? At this journey’s end, though, there was one final cry from a small group, a Roman centurion and the men who were with him keeping watch over Jesus. We are told they “feared greatly when they saw the earthquake, and all that was happening, and they said, “Truly, this was the Son of God!” As Lent comes to a close, **what was your journey like over the last forty days? Have you drawn closer to Jesus? Have you allowed him to come closer to you?**

**RCIA** Today we begin the holiest of weeks in the Catholic Christian calendar with the triumphant entrance of Jesus into Jerusalem where he is hailed as the Messiah. The Church celebrates Jesus’ entrance each year as we recall what he did to accomplish the mission he had been destined for. **We enter into Jerusalem** with Jesus and celebrate this holy week in preparation for the Easter *feast!*

These past five weeks we have *lived* the Lenten season which the Church asks us to participate in to lead us to a deeper conversion to Jesus Christ and to prepare us to celebrate Easter. Those who have been preparing to be baptized in the Church, **the Elect**, as well as the **Candidates**, have gone through a period of study called **Purification and Enlightenment**, to help them prepare their minds and hearts to become united with Jesus in his Catholic Church.

They have also gone through the **Scrutiny Rites** during these past three Sundays to help them and ourselves as well *uncover all that is sinful in us which keeps us from loving God more and celebrating all that is good and holy within us which keeps us more closely united to Jesus.* The **Rites** strengthen us to remain more faithful to Jesus’ amazing love as we experience forgiveness, healing and freedom from sin.

We are invited to become *radical disciples of Jesus* and to learn daily how we can become completely dependent upon him for our salvation.

On Wednesday in RCIA, we will learn about the Easter Triduum—Holy Thursday evening through Easter Sunday evening. St. Augustine speaks of the “triduum of Jesus crucified, buried and risen.” We recall the Passover meal on Holy Thursday and share in the supper which Jesus left to his Church to reveal his love. We hear one of the earliest written accounts of the Lord’s supper from 1 Corinthians 11:23-26: *“I received from the Lord what I handed on to you, that the Lord Jesus, on the night he was handed over, took bread and, after he had given thanks, broke it and said, ‘This is my body that is for you.’”* Jesus’ great commandment to *“love one another as I have loved you”* was given to us on Holy Thursday. His example of serving one another was also given to us on Holy Thursday which we recall in the *washing of the feet* of members of our community.

So, on Holy Thursday we celebrate the institution of the Eucharist and the Priesthood. The Eucharist offers us the holy, precious body and blood of **Jesus himself** to help us with the grace of the sacrament. The Eucharist is also meant to build up the unity of the Parish and the whole Body of Christ so that *“we who are nourished by his Body and Blood may be filled with the Holy Spirit, and become one body, one Spirit in Christ.”*

The Good Friday liturgy is somber—the altar is bare, there is no Mass—we gather in the Church for a reading of the Passion from John and join in the Church’s most solemn form of the General Intercessions. The third part of the Good Friday liturgy is our approaching the cross held by the ministers and reverence it with a touch or a kiss—our way of acknowledging **the glory of the cross, the very instrument of torture, cruelty and death for our Savior, Jesus Christ.** The service concludes with a simple Communion Service with the Eucharist from Holy Thursday.

On Holy Saturday, our Elect, Candidates and Confirmandi and their Sponsors will participate in a retreat from 7:30 am-12:30 pm. We will gather at 7:45 Holy Saturday evening where 4 of our Elect and 4 of our children will be Baptized in the new Easter waters:
