SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER/SUNDAY OF DIVINE MERCY: Fear can imprison not only our bodies, but also our minds and hearts. The apostles locked themselves in because they were afraid that those who had killed Jesus would come for them. But neither locked doors nor fear can keep Jesus out. Suddenly he is there, bringing peace, his first gift as risen Lord, flowing from his saving death. Then he shows them his wounds. Jesus not only opens his hands to them, but his heart. Again he says, “Peace,” but now he gives them two more gifts: a purpose in life and the power to fulfill it. First he tells them that he sends them out to continue the work the Father had given him: to proclaim God’s mercy to the world. Then comes *the* Easter gift. He breathes on them the Spirit: “Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained.” The Spirit brings God’s mercy in the form of forgiveness, drawing us into communion with the Father and the Son. **How often have you known this Spirit who brings forgiveness, both as one who is forgiven and as one who forgives?**



ADORATION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT: Is on the First Friday of each month from 9:30 am to 4:00 pm and every Tuesday at 5:00 pm. Please spend time with Our Lord in the Blessed Sacrament. This is a beautiful expression of love and gratitude to our Lord. **First Friday, May 2, 2014.** Being in the presence of God will change your life.

RCIA *CHRIST IS RISEN! ALLELUIA!! We rejoice and are glad because the Lord has done good things for us!* As we gathered in darkness at the Easter Vigil last Saturday, we experienced the services which began the celebration: the **Service of Light** and the **Blessing of Fire**. We remembered that as Jesus passed from death to life, we were celebrating this *Passover* in honor of his death and resurrection. We are assured that we, too, will share in his victory over death and live with him forever!

Our Elect journeyed to the fullness of Christian initiation after praying a litany of praise to the saints. They participated in the blessing of the Baptismal water and were *baptized* in this water as a sign of dying to self and being reborn in Jesus Christ. They were *clothed* in a white garment as they were reminded to bring themselves unstained to Jesus. They were presented with a *candle lit from the Easter candle*, reminding them of their new life in Christ and also that they must be a light to the world.

Our **“Neophytes”**, newly baptized, our Candidates and Confirmandi and we, ourselves, lived the season of Lent to prepare for the celebration of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday’s Easter Vigil. The Church gives us this time, year after year, to remember and make present the *Paschal Mystery*. Although this experience is heightened for **Orlando Romero, Daniel Espinoza, Leticia Atencio, Luisa Atencio, Mikella Flores, Martiza Vigil, Sarah Leon, Angela Leon**, who received Baptism and for **Andrea Cortez**, who made a Profession of Faith in the Catholic Church and for all those who were Confirmed and received First Communion, we are all called to marvel in our faith in Jesus Christ:

His Incarnation

His life lived in obedience to Mary and Joseph

His ministry of teaching and healing

His giving us HIS body and blood in the Eucharist

His sorrowful passion and death

HIS GLORIOUS RESURRECTION!

All those who completed their sacraments of Initiation at the Easter Vigil will continue coming to RCIA for a 7-week period called *Mystagogy*. It is during this time that the Church helps them discern their call as new Catholic Christians. They will continue learning how to grow in their faith and live St. Paul’s words: *“What good is faith without works.”* They will keep the teaching of Jesus in their hearts as they learn to live the Catholic way of life: *“When I was hungry you gave me to eat, when I was thirsty you gave me to drink, when I was without clothes you clothed me, sick and you visited me, in prison and you came to see me.”*

Come to experience the joy of the neophytes and those who completed their sacraments of Initiation this Wednesday from 7-9 pm and see the good work Jesus is doing at Iglesia Santa Cruz in preparing people for life in the Church. You may begin your formal journey of faith in RCIA this Wednesday to prepare for receiving sacraments at next year’s Easter Vigil.
