TWENTY-FIRST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: Certain questions are life-changers. “Do you take this person to be your husband/wife?” comes to mind. Jesus’ query to his disciples is another such question: “Who do you say that I am?” It invites a commitment. Simon Peter’s answer was correct, though his understanding was limited. Next week we are made aware how limited it was. Today we can appreciate its truthfulness. “You are the Christ, the Son of the living God,” Simon says. And Jesus responds immediately, “Blessed are you...For flesh and blood has not revealed this to you, but my heavenly Father.” We can hear Jesus asking each of us this day, “Who do *you* say that I am?” In other words, “Do you believe that I am the Son of God, your Savior, the One who came to bring you fullness of life?” To be able to say, “Yes, I do believe!” is a gift from our heavenly Father. To be able to live out this faith by following the example and teaching of Jesus is to be truly blessed.

Do you recognize that your faith is a gift? How do you thank God for it?

RCIA Once we have received the gift of faith, what must we do to insure continued growth in faith? Sometimes our faith suffers when we experience a time of crisis. In the process of faith, doubt does occur. *Faith is a living relationship* and living things are susceptible to growth. Kahlil Gibran once said, “We can forget those we have laughed with, but we can never forget those we have cried with.” Faith matures through crises (Hinman, Sinwell).

When we have doubts, we’re forced to look at and redefine our relationship with God. We can begin to understand what we really believe about our salvation. It can force us to hear the challenge Jesus offers us. . . ***“I came so that they may have life. . . life everlasting. . . take up your cross daily and follow after me. . . go and sin no more. . . why do you worry. . . don’t you know I take care of even the birds of the air and the lilies of the field? How much more will I take care of you. . . go out and teach them everything I have taught you and baptize them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.***

It is so important to hear Jesus in our doubting. We have to hear him calling us to follow him and then respond in renewed faith. If we truly want to be a follower of Jesus **and** his disciple we have to deny ourselves, let go of our material things, be willing to sacrifice for others, have self-respect for ourselves and respect for others. In living the Christ-style of life we may be made fun of or misunderstood and we definitely will have to make many sacrifices. In doing this, we are carrying the cross. We carry the cross every time we put the will of God first in our life and renounce sin in our life.

The meaning of Jesus’ death is life for the Catholic Christian. Through his death on the cross, Jesus put to death all that might separate us from God. He did this by the total giving of himself to the will of God. Only through Jesus’ death and resurrection do we have the promise of our own resurrection—our new life in Christ.

Jesus said, ***“I am the resurrection and the life.”*** We have to remember the promise of new life in Christ as we carry the cross. When we follow Jesus and the will of God, we find inner joy and peace. The promise Jesus offers gives us hope in times of great difficulty and darkness. Our experience of daily life is an on-going death-to-resurrection cycle. Sharing in the daily cross and resurrection is but a taste of the eternal life Jesus promises us.

RCIA is a journey of faith which allows us to renew our faith in Jesus and his Church. Each week we meet with adults who are seeking a better understanding of Jesus’ call to “follow after him.” RCIA prepares adults, and children, who want to learn more about the Church, the Bible, the lives of the saints, the apostolic tradition to prepare them to receive the sacraments.

Please invite someone who may need to complete their sacraments to come to RCIA. We meet this Wednesday from 7-8:30 in the RCIA room at the Religious Education Center.
