**FEAST OF THE PRESENTATION OF THE LORD:** Early in his public ministry, Jesus assured his disciples that he had come to fulfill, not abolish, the law and the prophets. In fact, we will hear that passage in just a couple of weeks. Today we see Jesus, while still an infant, doing just this. Forty days after his birth, Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the temple to present him to the Lord in accordance with the law of Moses. Jesus has come and fulfilled the law. Simeon, blessed by the Holy Spirit, and Anna, a prophet who dedicated her final years to fasting and prayer, each recognize the infant as the Anointed One who will save his people. Jesus has come and fulfilled the messianic prophecy. Patiently Simeon and Anna have waited for the Messiah. Now he has been revealed to them. Though they will not live to see that day, they have seen the salvation God has prepared and trust that it has come. The prophecy of Malachi in the first reading can now be the testimony of Hebrews in the second. Today Jesus is presented to us in this holy place. We encounter Christ, the Messiah, as did Simeon and Anna. Now we are charged, as they were, to proclaim his presence and his promise of salvation.

**RCIA** *The Vocation of Catholic Christians* is taken from Matthew's 5<sup>th</sup> Gospel(13-16). We are true followers of Jesus Christ if we are *the salt of the earth and the light of the world*. Isaiah teaches that we are the salt and the light when we do the "good works" described in Is. 58:7-10. We are not saved by our "good works," but because of our faith in Jesus, that faith *impels us* to live out our faith by doing good. God's love is revealed in our loving concern for others. So:

- ...if we want to see light in the darkness
- ...if we want to have our wounds healed
- ...if we want to have our prayers answered. . .
- ...we have to:
- ...feed the hungry
- ...shelter the homeless
- ...clothe the naked
- ...have compassion on the suffering of others.

Isaiah reminds us that we can fast all we want, but fasting without justice and care for the poor doesn't please God. Isaiah's prophetic message is not a warning of doom, but an understanding of a glorious future for those who serve God and God's people.

Jesus teaches us that *we are the salt of the earth*. . .without each one of us, the world would be flat and would lack the flavor it is supposed to have. Jesus also teaches us that *we are the light of the world*. . .so it is our awesome privilege to brighten the world by our acts of goodness. When others witness our actions for others, they will praise God. We are called to let our light shine all around.

We are meant to be lamps, not mirrors. A mirror only reflects what is before it. A lamp sheds light, casts shadows aside, illuminates, reveals detail adding variety in its color and brightens everything with warmth. Jesus is proclaiming what is, not what should be. . .*you are the light of the world*. . .*not you should be the light of the world*. *You are the salt of the earth*. . .*not you should be the salt of the earth*.

We have to be who and what we are. **We are salt and light**, for better or for worse. We have no choice except to decide to be quality salt and brighter light. Our *vocation* flows from this teaching. Jesus is calling each one of us to be his disciples, to give light and hope to others, to preserve our Catholic Christian values, to help others see where they are going.

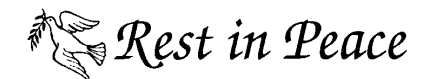
