FIFTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME: “What time is it?” is a familiar question. Today’s scriptures invite us to distinguish two kinds of time. The Greek language even has two different words: *chronos* meaning “clock time,” and *kairos*, meaning “the hour of grace.” Today we might call them “Job-time” and “Jesus-time.” Clock time can drag or, as Job puts it, life becomes drudgery, with months of misery, troubled nights, and life “coming to an end without hope.” But *kairos* also happens, those times when God’s healing, saving, life-giving power touches our lives. Mark shows this happening when Jesus preaches, “This is the time of fulfillment!” (1:15). It happens when he teaches “as one having authority,” casts out demons, raises up Peter’s mother-in-law, and heals all the sick brought to him. God’s grace is at work in and through Jesus. We are people who can live in two time zones, *chronos* and *kairos*. How? Notice what Jesus does when he gets up the next day. Clock time and grace time can come together when we make time to open our hearts to God in prayer.

RCIA Who is Jesus? What can we learn from him? What does he ask of us? Jesus asks us to trust in him. We are called to *take on the mind of Christ*, to imitate him and to do all we do in our lives for his glory. Jesus healed a leper not because the leper *knew about Jesus*, but because the leper had deep **faith** and believed he would be healed. God freely healed this leper through Jesus.


The leper's **faith** was the beginning of his conversion and it continued to grow as he went about telling people what Jesus had done for him. We, too, experience Jesus through the reading and study of the Bible, through believing in him in **faith**, through telling others about him, through our relationships with others and through the Church which is guided by the **Holy Spirit**.

Our **faith** forms the foundation of our attitudes, our values, our efforts, our character. As a community, the Roman Catholic Church has expressed its beliefs in the Creed, which is our doctrine, our statement of what we believe. Through the Creed, we the members of the Church say what we believe in our understanding of God who reveals himself in **faith**. **Faith** is a free, personal response. It cannot be forced or expected.

The creed is more than a list of things which we believe. It is a statement of our faith in the Word which we have heard proclaimed in the Scriptural readings and the homily. It is a profession of faith which leads us to give our lives for each other as Jesus gave his life for us. Originally, the Creed was the profession of faith of those about to be baptized at this point in the Mass. Each time we pray the Creed, we are proclaiming what we believe as followers of Jesus, as members of his one, holy, catholic and apostolic church.

Since it is our **faith** which forms our character,
We must watch our thoughts, because they become our words.
We must watch our words, because they become our actions.
We must watch our actions, because they become our habits.
We must watch our habits, because they become our character.
We must watch our character, because it becomes our destiny.

RCIA meets this Wednesday in the RCIA room from 7-9 pm. It is a journey of faith patterned after the way the first Christians studied and prayed and came to be baptized in the Catholic Christian faith. RCIA prepares adults to come to a deeper relationship with Jesus, and, in doing so, become more committed in their lifelong walk with Jesus. Adults are prepared to receive the Sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Holy Eucharist. Ben Esquibel will be our Catechist, teaching *Our Catholic Creed—Our Catholic Tradition*. Our children in RCIA will meet with Mary Ann Vigil.

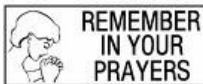
