SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT: Today we go up two mountains. After listening to God’s command, Abraham is ready to sacrifice his beloved son, Isaac, on Mt. Moriah. We are told God did this to test Abraham. It is a difficult story to read, much less understand. Was God uncertain whether Abraham trusted the promises God had made to him? Abraham, normally very talkative with God, falls into silence as he walks with Isaac, responding only to Isaac’s question about the sacrificial animal, saying, “God will provide” (Genesis 22:8). Hoping against hope, Abraham trusts God, becoming a model of faith. As the great flood prefigures the baptismal waters that destroy sin and bring new life, so too Abraham prefigures the Father whose love allowed the only Son to suffer and die so salvation would be available for all. On Mt. Tabor, another call to listen. After Jesus is transfigured, a foretaste of glory, the Father calls to his disciples: “This is my beloved Son. Listen to him.” In the coming Sundays, Jesus will speak about his approaching death and its meaning.
How will you prepare your heart to listen?

They were welcomed at the Basilica of St. Francis of Assisi by Archbishop Michael Sheehan last Sunday along with 200 others who are seeking to become Catholic. The Archbishop assured them of his prayers as they continue a more intense period of preparation in the RCIA journey of faith called *Purification and Enlightenment*. Those to be baptized at the Easter Vigil are now called “*the Elect*” because they have been “elected,” or chosen for Baptism.

Please pray for these Elect and Candidates as well as the Confirmandi who will receive sacraments at the Easter Vigil.

Our teachings for next week will come from Cycle A Readings and will remind us to ask ourselves where we are thirsting, where we are wandering in the darkness and entombed by sin. Our Elect, Candidates and their Sponsors will take part in the 1st Scrutiny at Mass. This Rite is meant to help those who will be baptized at the Easter Vigil to reflect on areas in their lives where they have been “stuck” in patterns of sin or fear and be led to a deeper conversion in Christ Jesus. They will come together with the church family to go through a process of purification and enlightenment during this Lenten season.

The Scrutiny Rite helps them and us to uncover all that keeps us from the love of God while strengthening us to remain more faithful to Jesus’ love. We come to experience forgiveness, healing and freedom from sin. We are invited to become **radical disciples of Christ** and we are helped to turn and become totally dependent upon God for our salvation.

Our teaching in RCIA will be on the thirst we have for Jesus. St. Paul tells us in Ephesians 5:8-14 that we **were** darkness but now we **are** sunlight itself. He is emphasizing the dramatic change which takes place at our baptism. Since we are now preparing for Easter and the renewal of our baptismal vows, we need to be reminded of what we were and what we are now!

This teaching is so important for the Elect. Light is closely associated with baptism. The early church called the newly baptized “**those who have been illuminated.**” The Church offers us continual help in renewing our baptism through the Sacrament of Reconciliation—Confession.

In John 9:1-41 we read the Gospel message of the man born blind. He was blind from birth. He couldn’t see the light until Jesus covered his eyes with mud, sent him to the pool of Siloam to wash and his sight was restored. This story reminds us of baptism and Jesus, who has been sent from God and SENDS US forth through our baptismal commission to be a light in the darkness of the world.


You are invited to meet with us to share your desire to come to the light of Jesus during this rich Lenten season.
