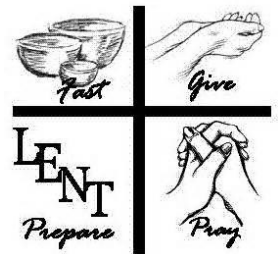

**FOURTH SUNDAY OF LENT:** God is a God of reversals. The opening of today’s Gospel refers to God reversing the situation when Israel was in the desert and poisonous, serpents were causing death among the rebellious Israelites. A sign of rebellion became a sign of God’s power. For God had ordered Moses to elevate a serpent of bronze, promising that all who looked on it would be saved. Jesus uses that memory to help us understand his own lifting up on the cross as offering salvation to all who look on this event with faith. When we look on the cross with faith, John’s Gospel invites us to see God’s merciful love revealed in Jesus crucified. Our conversion is yet another reversal, when the grace of God helps bring about a turning away from sin toward God’s forgiveness. This is the purpose of Lent: our drawing nearer to God, so rich in mercy. This springtime for the soul, this season of blossoming into new life, is a gift. As Ephesians reminds us: We are saved not by our own works, but through faith, a gift of God’s grace.

**RCIA** Today our Elect and Candidates participate in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Scrutiny at Mass as they move toward Baptism and a deeper commitment to Jesus Christ in His holy, catholic Church. In today's Scrutiny Rite, we celebrate our release from the winter despair of sin to the spring of hope in Jesus Christ. We turn with firm purpose to the warm glow of Jesus' resurrected life.

In John 11, Jesus is faced with the painful reality that his friend, Lazarus, has died. He experiences great loss and emptiness as he weeps for him. We, too, have this experience when someone close to us dies. We feel this pain to a different degree when we hear of tragedies involving deaths in our community and in our world—we are hearing more and more of the brutal deaths happening by ISIS in the Middle East and in Africa.

Jesus raises Lazarus to life. His focus is God and the work of God. Everything Jesus does is meant to focus on the abundance and the compassion of our heavenly Father. Jesus *restores life* to Lazarus who appeared to be dead; he gave hope where things seemed hopeless and a clear vision for tomorrow where grief seemed to be the only answer.

Miracles are a sign of God's glory. In this miracle, which parallels so closely his own death, Jesus helps the people in their belief by showing that **HE IS LIFE!** He thanks the Father for having heard him. Only through the Father does he raise Lazarus from the dead. He calls us to have life, the fullness of life, a life that will go on forever. . .his life!

Jesus waits four days before going to Bethany. It was Jewish tradition that the soul stayed near the body for three days after death and Jesus wants to make sure that Lazarus is dead. Martha, Lazarus' sister, knows Jesus is a healer, but now she will know him as *life!* "I am the resurrection and the life. . .life that will never end. "Whoever lives and believes in me will never die." Lazarus was not resurrected. His corpse was resuscitated. Lazarus returned from the dead. The breath of life flowed in him. He walked again with his family and friends as the same man he was before.

This is not the same experience as the hope we have in the resurrection. In Jesus' resurrection, he was raised to glory and was **changed. . .transformed!** He no longer had an earthly body. The whole person of Jesus, his total humanity and all his relationships, become transformed into God forever.

This is our hope. . .this is our promise. In Jesus' resurrection we have been assured of a new and transformed life. We have the possibility now of sharing in this transformed life of Jesus even before our death.

Our teaching Wednesday is titled, "The Lamb of God. . .Jesus is our Savior!" Jesus journeyed to Jerusalem to do his Father's work. Some of the people welcomed him with palm branches calling out, "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" And these same people, a few days later, cry out, "Crucify him!" Jesus continues to love us and forgive us even when we:

Miss Mass. . .forget to pray. . .lose our courage to stand for our convictions. . .fail to serve our neighbor. . .abandon our faith. . .and when we fail to love one another.

We hope you can come to RCIA this Wednesday.

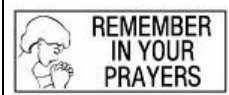
