# RCIA

Today begins our holiest week with the triumphant entry of Jesus into Jerusalem, as people hail him as Messiah only to condemn him to death a week later. We *celebrate* this entrance into the Church as we remember what Jesus did to *accomplish* his mission. We *enter into Jerusalem with Jesus* as we recall the holiest week of all Christianity and we enter into our final preparation for the Easter *feast!*

We have lived the Lenten season which the Church gives us to lead us to a deeper conversion in Christ. Those who have been preparing to be baptized in the Church, the **Elect**, as well as the **Candidates** preparing for Baptism and First Communion, have been given the opportunity to purify their minds to ask where they recognize the sin in their lives which keeps them from receiving God’s complete and total love. They’ve also recognized the goodness and holiness of their lives in the hopes of continuing to be strengthened in this goodness. They have been called through the **Scrutiny Rites**, to remain faithful to Jesus’ love as they experience forgiveness, healing and freedom from sin. They, as well as the **Confirmandi**, and ourselves, are invited to become *radical disciples of Jesus*, becoming completely dependent on him for our salvation.

On Wednesday in RCIA we will reflect on Holy Week and the **Easter Triduum—Holy Thursday through Easter Sunday evening**. St. Augustine speaks of the “triduum of Christ crucified, buried and risen.” We recall the Passover meal on Holy Thursday and share in the supper which Jesus left to his Church to reveal his love. We hear one of the earliest written accounts of the Lord’s Supper from 1 Corinthians 11:23-26: *“I received from the Lord what I handed on to you, that the Lord Jesus, on the night he was handed over, took bread, and, after he had given thanks, broke it and said, ‘This is my body that is for you.’”*

We are given Jesus’ commandment to *“love one another as I have loved you.”* Jesus reveals his love through serving others and we experience what Jesus did to teach this to us in the washing of the feet of the disciples. On Holy Thursday we also recall **the institution of the Eucharist and the Priesthood**. The Eucharist offers us the holy, precious body and blood of **Jesus himself!** To help us with the grace of this sacrament. . .it is also meant to build up the unity of the parish and the whole Body of Christ so that, *“we who are nourished by his Body and Blood, may be filled with the Holy Spirit, and become **one body, one Spirit in Christ.**”*

The Good Friday liturgy is somber. . .the altar is bare, there is no Mass. . .we gather in Church for a reading of the Passion from John and join in the Church’s most solemn form of the General Intercessions. The third part of the Good Friday liturgy is our approaching the cross held by the ministers and reverence it with a touch or a kiss. . .our way of acknowledging the **glory of the cross**, the very instrument of torture, cruelty and death for our Savior. The service concludes with a Communion Service with the blessed Eucharist from Holy Thursday.

On Holy Saturday we gather for the Easter Vigil where our Elect will be baptized, confirmed and receive Holy Communion for the first time. Our children who will be baptized will also receive First Communion. We will also have several adults who are completing their final sacrament of Initiation—Confirmation. Come to celebrate these glorious 3 days with all of us!

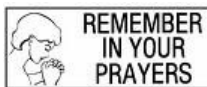
