Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time: As we enter these final days of Ordinary Time, the scriptures begin to turn our attention to the end times. Saint Paul warns us that “the day of the Lord will come like a thief at night.” It is interesting to note that the season of Ordinary Time began way back in January with John the Baptist pointing to Jesus and declaring him to be the “Lamb of God.” From the moment John sounded that announcement, the Lord Jesus has been our guide and leader, calling us into greater discipleship. Today he asks us not to bury the treasures entrusted to us at Baptism, but to invest those treasures—our gifts and talents—to help further the reign of God. **Name one way that you have used a natural gift or talent to help in the furthering of the Lord’s work here on earth.**

Remain in me as I remain in you, says the Lord. Whoever remains in me bears much fruit. (John 15: 4a, 5b)

RCIA Next Sunday, the Church celebrates the Feast of Christ the King. It will be the last Sunday in Cycle A of the Church's Liturgical Calendar, the calendar used by our Church to continuously teach us about our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ. It begins with:

- the prophecies in the Old Testament of the Savior who was to be born
- his birth in Nazareth 2000 years ago
- his life of obedience to Mary and Joseph
- his teachings and the call of his apostles
- his sufferings through his passion
- his death
- his resurrection

The Biblical teachings proclaimed in the Catholic Church every Sunday and Holy Day continue to teach us the truths of our salvation. The cycles of the Liturgical Calendar are:

Year A

Year B

Year C

They are proclaimed over a period of three years, opening up for us the entire Bible! So, every three years of faithfully participating in Mass, we hear the entire Bible proclaimed one time!

In celebrating the Feast of Christ the King, we have to see ourselves as **his subjects**. What should this mean for us? It means we must always seek his guidance to do his will, to be generous with our time, talent and treasure and to always be humble in our dealings with others.

"The kingdom of God is at hand," so we are living in kingdom life **right now**. How do we know we're living his kingdom life right now? It is by the way we show mercy to others. Because Jesus' kingdom is one of mercy and love, we welcome the stranger, we give drink to the thirsty, we clothe the naked, we comfort the sick, we visit the imprisoned. . . not only those in prison, but those who are imprisoned in loneliness or fear or helplessness. . .

That is how we come to live the kingdom life—because we see Jesus in each other. That is how we will *"inherit the kingdom prepared for us from the creation of the world."* We must pattern our lives after the Holy Family of Nazareth—Jesus, Mary and Joseph. The Nazareth life is available to us through the **daily study** of our faith through reading Scripture and the lives of the Saints. The Nazareth life is available to us through our prayer with our family and through our service to one another in love and devotion.

To honor Jesus Christ as King, we have to ask him to become the king of our heart, so that all we do will be for his glory and honor. As Catholic Christians, we must always use the gift of **knowledge** which we receive from the Holy Spirit to understand what the Kingship of Christ means to us in our families. Our **understanding**, another gift from the Holy Spirit, **grows in every choice we make of life over death**. We look to Jesus in our hunger and thirst, desiring more of him and less of material satisfaction.
