COMMEMORATION OF ALL THE FAITHFUL DEPARTED—ALL SOULS’ DAY: Recently a friend told me that someone had discouraged her from praying for the dead, saying she should pray only for the living who need it more. Our Catholic tradition encourages both. Today’s feast goes back to the monks of Cluny in 988 A.D. and was accepted by Rome in the thirteenth century. It carries on an even older tradition. In his encyclical *Saved in Hope*, Pope Emeritus Benedict reminds us that early Jewish tradition holds the idea that one can help those gone before us through prayer (see 2 Maccabees 12: 38-45). Furthermore, he adds, it has been a fundamental conviction of Christianity that love can extend to the afterlife and reciprocal giving and receiving are possible. Our affection for one another endures beyond the bounds of death. God’s word comforts us as we pray, reminding us that the souls of the just are in God’s hands and at peace, and the faithful shall abide with God in love (Wisdom 3); that we have been reconciled to God by the death of the Son (Romans 5); and that the father’s will is that everyone who believes in the Son will have eternal life.

RCIA

“We Worship in Holy Temples” is our teaching in RCIA this Wednesday. The Basilica of St. John Lateran is the Cathedral of the Holy Father, Pope Francis, in Rome. It is the Pope’s diocesan cathedral and it holds the papal throne. It is, therefore, considered to be the mother church of **all Christians**. Many people mistakenly think that St. Peter’s Basilica is the cathedral of Rome, but that is not correct. The Lateran Basilica has a baptistery which has inscribed a famous text of Pope Sixtus III where he described Baptism:

“Hope for the Kingdom of Heaven, you who are reborn in this font.

Eternal life does not await those who are only born once.

This is the spring of life that waters the whole world

taking its origins from the Wounds of Christ.

Sinner, to be purified, go down into the holy water.”

We are the church, but we celebrate the buildings which house God’s holy people. We hear of everything good which comes from the water flowing out of Solomon’s temple. Then Paul asks the Corinthians: **“Are you not aware that you are the temple of God, and that the spirit of God dwells in you?”** Paul is reminding the Corinthians and us that **we** are the temple of God:

from living stones, your chosen people, you built an eternal temple to your glory.

Even though we know that we were made to be those temples of holiness, sometimes there are false gods in this temple. . . gods of wealth, power, enmity, lust, greed, thievery. . . sometimes people bow down before other gods, like economic and political systems. Each Sunday and Holy Day when we gather as the people of God, we are reminded about the holiness of the presence of Jesus in the Holy Eucharist and therefore the holiness of the **temple** where we worship.

When we enter the church building, we genuflect in the presence of our Savior and Lord. When we leave at the end of Mass, we genuflect again, recognizing and honoring his presence in the Tabernacle. We carry the presence of Jesus within us, in our holy temples, offering life to others. So, there is holiness within the temples in which we worship **and** we are the temples of Jesus in our families and communities.

An invitation is extended to all adults who desire to grow in their faith to come to RCIA. We meet from 7-9 every Wednesday evening in the Religious Education Center. Children meet from 7-8:30 pm to prepare for Baptism.
