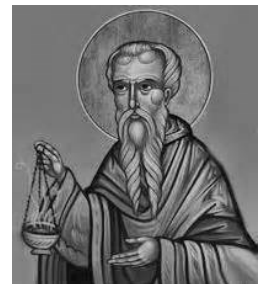

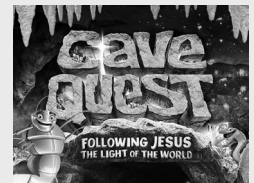

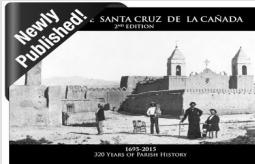

RCIA From the 12th through the 34th Sunday in Ordinary Time, St. Luke teaches us in his Gospel how the Church was formed and purified by Jesus as he begins his great journey to Jerusalem with his disciples accompanying him. Jesus' journey is a journey to God. We in the Church journey with Jesus. Our life with Jesus is one of constant movement, growth and development. We "go before" Jesus and prepare the way for his coming. We are like John the Baptist *preparing the way of the Lord*.

Jesus' mind and attitude toward people is important for us to remember. We cannot condemn or harshly judge those who don't follow Jesus or those who try to keep others from following. In the Gospel for next week from Luke (9:51-62), there are three people who want to follow Jesus. They each tell him they first have to fulfill prior obligations before they can follow him.

Jesus tells the first person he has to become detached from the security of a home or from the comfort of **things**. To the second person Jesus sways that if he really wants to follow him he must become detached from **previous responsibilities**. He tells the third person he has to be detached from **past relationships**. What Jesus is saying to each one of them is that following him requires a *radical commitment* in spreading the kingdom of God by the life they will lead. Our priests are a wonderful example of this *radical commitment they make to be our priests*.

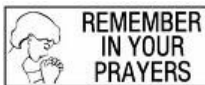
What does following Jesus mean for us? What values in character, what qualities, what attributes must we have so that others know we are committed to being followers of Christ. . .

Christians? If we follow Christ, do we walk in the way of the cross or do we follow an easier way? Jesus teaches us that *unless we take up our cross daily and follow after him, we have no part in his kingdom*.

How do we follow Christ? Do we follow him through faithful study of the Bible. . .through faithful participating in Mass. . .through becoming ministers in the Church (Lectors, Ministers of the Eucharist, Ushers, Music Ministers, Acolytes). . .through our help at the San Martin Soup Kitchen or teaching our young children as Catechists and our teens in the Confirmation Classes, or volunteering to work in St. Vincent de Paul helping those in need, or with Catholic Daughters or the Knights? How about coming to RCIA to grow in faith? Do we visit and help the elderly, those who are sick or those who are grieving at the loss of a loved member of their family? Do we volunteer in community programs such as 4-H or Girls and Boy Scouts?

Which Jesus do we follow? Do we follow the Jesus of our own making who allows us to make our own rules and live our own lifestyle? Or do we follow the Jesus of the Gospels who is always dedicated to helping the poor and the oppressed, who loves unconditionally, who forgives our sins and whose promises we can depend on?

Following Jesus is not easy—we can't make excuses—we can't postpone our commitment. We have to trust that Jesus' way is the way which leads to salvation. We have to be dedicated and single-minded in our purpose and not become distracted from our mission. We have the Church to guide us in our travelling this road of faith together with Jesus as **The Way!** Come to RCIA this Wednesday to let Jesus help you on your journey to **HIM!**

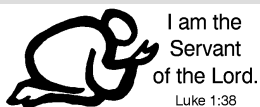
